Procedures for Recycling and Disposal

➤ **Cans, Plastic Bottles / Wrapping and Cups**

There are specific containers for cans, plastic bottles and plastic cups which can be found within the pantries in the college premises.

➤ **Confidential paper**

Small quantities of confidential data should be destroyed in the local shredding machines and will be removed by the relevant person from waste collection points.

➤ **Non-Confidential Waste Paper, Magazines, Journals, etc.**

This can be placed at the designated recycling bins.

➤ **Non-recyclable Office Waste**

This can be placed into the General Waste Bin prepared within college premises.

➤ **Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment**

This will be collected by the IT and will be sent to related recycling organisations for further processing.
